Until now, the distribution of the town's Newsletter (*Kouhou*) and the neighbourhood's Circular Notice (*Kairanban*) and the collection of the Council of Social Welfare membership fee at the Residential Buildings for Employment Promotion were all made by the president of the building residents' association. However, due to the change of the buildings' administration (now, a private company), from April 2018, the Newsletter will not be distributed by the president of the building residents' association anymore. Instead, it will be distributed by the Neighbourhood Residents' Association.

Hereafter, the distribution of the Newsletter, as well as the Circular Notice, will be available only for members of the Neighbourhood Residents' Association.

A safe and secure life in our own hands!


